
Frieda's talk on the Chatham Islands was a fascinating look at the up-to-date version of the history of this area. We all seemed to learn something we had not been aware of before.

*Topic*: Building Environmental Guardians Using Sustainable Long-Distance Trails

Rod Donald Banks Peninsula Trust shot into the headlines earlier this year with its fundraising campaign to purchase Te Ahu Pātiki - an iconic landscape above Lyttelton Harbour including the two highest peaks on the Peninsula – Mt Herbert and Mt Bradley. A new conservation park is now underway protecting public access to the summits and a huge area of regenerating forest in between. Suky will introduce the Trust, tell you about its ambitious Te Ara Pātaka track project to create a tramping and cycling track from Christchurch to Akaroa, and update you on legacy it is now creating for future generations through Te Ahu Pātiki Park.
